Others: Mike Terry, Wyatt Johnson and Tipton Tribune.


Mayor Havens opened the June 21, 2016 Special Board of Public Works and Safety meeting.
Old Business:

2016 Paving Bids: Mayor Havens reported the bids were received at the last meeting and now have been reviewed by City Engineer Johnson. City Engineer Johnson reported both bids are in order. He also reported Baumgartner is considerably lower than E&B and the spread is across 7 of the 12 base bid pay items. City Engineer Johnson recommended Baumgartner base bid in the amount of \$254,247.04. He also reported no one made math mistakes or transposed numbers on their bids. Mayor Havens stated the milling asphalt is \$2.20 (Baumgarnter) to \$5.30 (E&B Paving), why is that. Engineer Johnson stated maybe sub because the milling guys are very busy. It was stated the Engineer's estimate needs to be pretty accurate, you want it to be close but it won't be exact. Engineer Johnson reported he talked to Public Works Manager Terry and we are going to track the weigh tickets as they go. He also reported we will have the same Superintendent from Baumgartner as we had last year, so he is going to talk to him about the weigh tickets. Engineer Johnson reported the Bid Form 96 needs signed on the second page to accept the base bid. The alternates will be done by the Utilities and ahead of the contractor. Engineer Johnson reported he felt confident that the Utilities would be able to do the inlets ahead of the contractor. Mayor Havens stated at their cost. Mayor Havens stated the spreadsheet given to us with the agenda it has ADA Sidewalks with Baum what is that. Engineer Johnson reported we don't need them they were provided in case we need to pay from different funds. When we pave through an intersection we are supposed to make the corners compliant to ADA. Public Works Manager reported the numbers provided were E&B numbers. Engineer Johnson reported he would update the spreadsheet with correct numbers. Mayor Havens asked how many corners are included. Engineer Johnson reported there are 60 corners included in the base bid. The alternates are for the inlets that the Utility are going to do. Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the bid from Baumgartner for the 2016 Paving Project for base without alternate in the amount of \$254,247.04, seconded by Councilman Curnutt, with all in favor. Mayor Havens asked when the work would start. Engineer Johnson reported he wasn't sure but he knew Jim Purvis with Baumgartner's was trying to use Tragesser for the sidewalk work. Public Works Manager Terry asked Engineer Johnson if he will be performing inspections on the project. Engineer Johnson reported yes he will be doing this. Mayor Havens asked if anyone else had any questions.

Adjournment: With no further business, Councilman Curnutt called for adjournment, seconded by Councilman Morgan, with all in favor.
