

City of Tipton Common Council Public Hearing held on July 11, 2016 at Tipton City Hall,
Council Chambers, Tipton.

Members Present: Mayor Havens, Councilman Curnutt, Morgan, Ogden and Rippy and Clerk-
Treasurer Clark. Councilman Clark was not present.

Others: Kevin McCormack, Nathan Kring and Liam Huss.

Mayor Havens opened the Public Hearing at 5:15 p.m. on the McCormack Printing Impressions
(MPI) tax abatement.

EDO Director, Nathan Kring reported there is nothing different to report from last meeting. He
reported they were one-point shy of granting the tax abatement and the Indiana Code
allows Council to modify tax abatements. So he suggested granting a five-year tax
abatement for McCormack Printing Impressions. Mayor asked if there was any reason
why it wouldn't qualify. Kring reported abatements are not available for retail but he
doesn't feel that MPI wouldn't qualify.

Mr. Kevin McCormack reported he would appreciate it but if we don't get the tax abatement we
will still be staying.

Mayor Havens asked if anyone from the public would like to comment.


Councilman Morgan asked about the Resolution 2016-07. Clerk-Treasurer Clark reported we
