

City of Tipton Common Council Public Hearing held on September 12, 2016 at Tipton City Hall, Council Chambers, Tipton.

Members Present: Mayor Havens, Councilman Curnutt, Morgan, Clark, Ogden and Rippy and Clerk-Treasurer Clark.

Mayor Havens opened up the Public Hearing at 5:15 p.m. on Resolution 2016-09 an additional appropriation in LOIT Special Distribution Fund. The additional appropriation is for \$129,000. He asked if any member of the public would like to be heard.

Roberta Heinzmann asked what the \$129,000 was for. Mayor Havens reported under Supplies – Bituminous \$75,000 and Capital Outlays – Grant Match \$54,000 for a total of \$129,000. He also reported we have another grant but that will not be in 2017 for the Cleveland project.


Mayor Havens reported under LOIT (Local Option Income Tax) Senate Act 67 that was passed where the Senate returned money to units of government and our share was \$472,048.73. The bill required 75% to be placed in a LOIT Special Distribution Fund and it was to be used for certain things such as roads and streets. The other 25% was receipted into the Rainy Day Fund and could be used for any other purpose of the City.


Roberta Heinzmann asked if Cleveland Street would be done this year or next year. Mayor Havens reported next year as far as building the street. The utility stormwater should be done this year. He also reported asphalt plants shut down in November that is why the building of the street won't be until next year.

Mayor Havens explained to the students that in a public hearing the Council has to hear what the public has to say. We don't have to answer their question, just listen, but you normally accommodate these comments.

Councilman Ogden called for the public hearing to be closed at 5:22 p.m., seconded by Councilman Rippy, with all in favor.
