- Mayor Havens opened the Public Hearing on the 2020 Budget at 5:15 p.m.
- Mayor Havens reported this is a hearing in which the public has the right to express itself on the 2020 Proposed Budget. Is there anyone that would like to speak in favor of the 2020 budget. No comment. He asked if there was anyone that would like to speak against the 2020 budget. No comment.
