County Council Comments

Jeff Hoover reported that he had attended a meeting of the Community Corrections Advisory Board. He stated that the State had chosen Tipton County for Evidence Based Decision Making. He stated that the State should not legislate and then not fund the mandate; for example, Level 6 felons now being housed by the counties.

Jim Purvis reported on a recent Plan Commission meeting at which a minor subdivision and zoning text amendments were approved defining procedures for handling minor and major plan changes. He also stated that the Plan Commission is starting a review of the Comprehensive Plan in view of the work being done to US31. There is a study committee on road frontage (streetscape) and they are considering city level, as well.

Mike Terry reported on the Ambulance Oversight Board. He stated that two of the four bids received for ambulance service had been presented to the Board of Commissioners. The Board of Commissioners will ask for new quotes.

Jim Ashley reported meeting with INDOT regarding the US31 corridor. He stated that the rail overpass was re-scheduled from the Fall of 2019 to the Fall of 2020 and that the Division Road is being planned and funded as an interchange and that it is in program.

Mike Terry reported that the first priority is elimination of the four stoplights between Indianapolis and South Bend and addressing railroad crossings.

Jim Purvis stated that the Plan Commission has updated the Comprehensive Plan and Transportation Plan based on traffic counts.

Jim Ashley stated that INDOT would be doing opportunity buying along US31, as properties come up for sale.

Jim Purvis announced a trail organization meeting at the Tipton Lions Club, September 18, 2019, at 6pm.

Jim Ashley stated that he had spoken to Emily Williams at IMPA concerning the landscaping plan that had not been submitted to the Council for approval. He said that he offered to send a list of ten to twelve suggestions to use as a guide to bring a plan to the County Council.

The Council entertained comments by the public.
