Monday, August 20, 2018 at 12:30 pm

MEMBERS PRESENT: Jim Mullins, Mark Manier, Gerald Shuck, Jason Henderson, Heather Terry

CALL MEETING TO ORDER: President Shuck called the meeting to order.

MODIFICATIONS TO AGNEDA: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Jim Mullins made a motion to accept the July 23, 2018 meeting minutes as presented. Mark Manier 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. With no further discussion, the motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS: Cargill / Silas-Tolin Tile: Cargill had an approved septic system but they failed to protect the system, therefore, they have to move the septic system to a different location. This new location is about the only site available and is near a county regulated drain. The drain has an inlet already in it. The perimeter drain will be about 18 feet from the drain. The closest finger will be about 41 feet from the drain. Wyatt is asking permission to encroach on the drain easement. Jason stated this presented plan still leaves the county enough room for any necessary county tile work and he is in favor of the request. Jim Mullins made a motion to authorize the requested encroachment as presented. Mark Manier 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. With no further discussion, the motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS: Dobson / Campbell: This project is progressing well. Jason had a meeting with some of the landowners and they are all geared up for this. This project will require a hearing in October. Several landowners will front-load their financial portion.

SURVEYOR REPORT:

West Elwood: There is a meeting scheduled with the recommended grant writer and one with the recommended engineer. Elwood personnel that had positive experiences with them recommended both of these.

Henry Stillwagner: Jason will complete this research and work when the crops come off and then make a full report to the board.

Jason mentioned that in October he is planning for a public hearing for the George Julius Regulated drain vacation.

Hutcherson: There will be a public hearing in October to begin the collection of funds in Tipton County for this drain.

ADJOURNMENT: Jim Mullins made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mark Manier 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. With no further discussion the motion passed.
