

City of Tipton Common Council Public Hearing held on October 14, 2019, at Tipton City Hall, Council Chambers, Tipton.

Members: Mayor Havens, Councilmen Curnutt, Morgan, Chandler, Ogden and Rippy and Clerk-Treasurer Clark.

Mayor Havens opened the Public Hearing on the Additional Appropriation in LIT Public Safety at 5:15 p.m.

Mayor Havens stated there are two members of the public are currently present and he asked them if they had any comments. There were no comments.

It was reported the additional appropriation amount is \$109,806 in LIT Public Safety.

Mayor Havens: Mr. Niblick arrived and he asked him if he would like to speak for or against the additional appropriation in LIT Public Safety. No comment. Mayor Havens stated we are seven minutes into the public hearing and only three members of the public are present, and they don't wish to address the Additional Appropriation in LIT.

Mayor Havens commented that Council should hold the public hearing on the proposal as advertised. At the public hearing, action shall be taken to approve, modify, or disapprove the proposed additional appropriation as advertised. The fiscal body can postpone action on the request. Mayor Havens asked is there is any desire among the Council to postpone action on the request. Hearing none, the Mayor asked what action you desire. Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the Additional Appropriation, seconded by Councilman Curnutt, with all in favor. Mayor Havens stated the Additional Appropriation was approved at the Public Hearing and will come up in the Council meeting under Ordinance and Resolutions.
