

What Can Be Recycled? (Subject to Change)

Unfortunately, not everything can be recycled. Below are examples of what can and cannot be recycled. Please ask if you have questions or call us at 765-675-9006.

We ask that you clean and separate your items to the best of your ability for quality processing and contamination reduction. Do your best!

We Accept:

- **Plastic Containers** with recycling logo on bottom 1-7.
- **Paper/Cardboard** Junk mail, office paper, newspapers & inserts, magazines, telephone books, catalogs. Shredded paper please bag separately. **Please separate paper and cardboard.**
- **Glass** food and beverage jars and bottles (labels are OK)
- **Steel/Tin Cans** (Labels are OK)
- **Aluminum** beverage cans (please bag separately)
- **Lithium and Rechargeable Batteries** (alkaline batteries can be disposed of in your trash)

Cell phones - Fire Extinguishers - Light Bulbs - Smoke alarms - Sharps
(in sealed containers)

Please see the fee list for the items below:

- **Electronics** (E-waste)
- **Fluorescent bulbs**
- **Televisions**
- **Tires**
- **Appliances**

Not Recyclable:

- **Plate glass, windows, art glass, mirrors**
- **Ceramic, glass cook-ware or unclean items** (don't want to cause contamination).
- **Styrofoam**
- **PPE is not to be recycled at our facility.** Please put these in your trash.
- **Wax Cartons:** (juice boxes, protein shakes, broth). Please dispose of these items with your trash.
- **Construction Debris**
- **Clothing, Shoes**

Residential Household Hazardous Waste

Home Improvement

Oil based paints, varnish, paint thinner, adhesives, glues, driveway sealants (Note: latex paint is water-based. Remove the lid, allow to dry and dispose of the can in your regular trash.

Cleaning and Household

Drain openers, oven cleaner, bleach, ammonia, furniture polish

Lawn and Garden

Pesticides, Herbicides, Weed Killers, chemical fertilizers, insecticides and pool chemicals.

Garage and Automotive

Motor oil, brake fluid, gasoline, kerosene, transmission fluid

NOTE: **Residential only.** Fees per 2021 Fee Schedule are:

\$1.00 per container (size is one gallon or less)

\$5.00 per 5-gallon container. No containers will be accepted that are greater than 5 gallons.

CATEGORY	FEE	EXAMPLES/REQUIREMENTS
ELECTRONICS/APPLIANCES	\$5/item	Fridge, Computers, Laptops, Washers, etc. Anything with a “plug” or internal electrical components.
Paint, Oil, & Automotive (RESIDENTIAL ONLY)	\$5/Gallon (1 gallon minimum)	Paint (oil based ONLY – NO L ATEX: label must be readable), motor oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, heating oil, etc.
Chemicals & Household Waste (RESIDENTIAL ONLY)	\$1 per container under 1 gallon \$5 per container over 5 gallons	Household cleaners, pesticides, round up, pool chemicals, etc. WE DO NOT ACCEPT UNLABELED MATERIALS.
Tires	\$5/tire no rim \$10/tire w/rim \$15.00 semi	No tire over 54”
Bulbs, lightbulbs, etc.	\$4/ea Fluorescent	
Televisions	.50 per pound \$20.00 over 40 pounds
